4. No one under the age of 18 can operate any of the state equipment.
5. Your Trail Association is responsible for any accidents which may take place while  
operating the state equipment.
6. All equipment must be returned filled with fuel and clean. If this has not been  
completed your Trail Association's operating budget will be charged with these  
expenses.
7. The state equipment is only to be used on the state snowmobile trails for signing, trail  
grubbing, or enforcement purposes.
8. All state equipment can only be signed out for two weeks periods.
